- Represents, along with the entire Board as a whole, the interests and needs of the Library
- Maintains an awareness of library issues and trends, and the implications for patrons
- Acts as a liaison with the public, government bodies, agencies, and other libraries
- Advocates for and supports library services and funding
- Ensure the Library is well-managed, financially secure, and operating suitably for the community
