

CONRAD PUBLIC LIBRARY
POLICY: COMMUNITY EXHIBITS AND DISPLAYS

The Conrad Public Library provides an exhibition space for individuals and non-profit groups in order for them to promote their art, activities, history, cultural heritage, and/or current projects. The space may not be used for exhibits that are commercial in nature, promote a specific religious concept, espouse partisan politics, or demean groups or individuals. Space for each exhibit will be determined by library staff. The library reserves the right to place limits on location, duration, and size of exhibits.

Exhibited items may not be labeled with prices. If the items are for sale, the exhibitor may provide a price list complete with contact information, copies of which will be given out at the front desk upon request. The Library will not handle any sales transactions.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to set up, maintain, and remove the exhibit. The Library assumes no responsibility for either damage to or the preservation, protection, or theft of any item displayed or exhibited. All items placed in the Library are done at the owner's risk.

Exhibitions do not imply endorsement by the Library. The Conrad Public Library Board of Trustees or the Library Director reserve the right to approve or disapprove any proposed exhibit and its location.
