

**CONRAD PUBLIC LIBRARY
POLICY: PROGRAMS**

Conrad Public Library-initiated programs utilize library worker expertise to support the mission of the library by providing users with additional opportunities for accessing information, education, and recreation. Programs may be held at the library building, off-site at a different location, or online, and may be presented by library workers, volunteers, or partners.

Registration may be required for planning purposes or when space is limited; registration (complete with a parent's signature) is required for many of the children's programs.

The Library may participate in cooperative or joint programs with other agencies, organizations, institutions, or individuals to facilitate information access in the community. A program's content, products, services, materials, and the views expressed by the presenter(s) and/or participants(s) does not constitute the Conrad Public Library's endorsement, nor does the Library assume any legal liability or responsibility of the program's accuracy or completeness.

Programming is offered free of charge to patrons, unless designed as a fundraising event by a Conrad Public Library supporting organization.

The Conrad Public Library reserves the right to use photographs taken during programs for use in promoting the Library within publications, marketing materials (such as the website), and social media; a child's photo can be used unless otherwise noted on the registration form.
