

**CONRAD PUBLIC LIBRARY
POLICY: ELEVATOR**

The Conrad Public Library elevator's intended use is to allow patron access on the main and second floors, as an alternative to the stairs, during the Library hours and/or scheduled events. While the Library strives to provide this service uninterrupted, equipment can be subject to maintenance and unforeseen failures that cause access to become unavailable; no guarantees of elevator service are expressed or implied.

If a patron(s) abuse of use occurs on the elevator, the patron be held legally accountable for any/all damages. Children under the age of ten (10) are not allowed in the elevator unless supervised by a parent or caregiver. Patrons assume all liability for any loss, damage, or injury arising from use of services provided and hold harmless the Conrad Public Library against any liability or responsibility arising from access to or use of the elevator.

The elevator may be locked at the discretion of the Library staff.
