

CONRAD PUBLIC LIBRARY
POLICY: HOURS OF SERVICE

In accordance with [ARM § 10.102.1159](#), the Conrad Public Library will be open for patron access a minimum of thirty (30) hours per week. Library hours of service to patrons shall be determined by the Library Director and approved by the Conrad Public Library Board of Trustees ([MCA § 22-1-309](#)).

Regular hours open to patrons at the Conrad Public Library (located at 15 4th Avenue Southwest, Conrad, Montana) are as follows:

Sundays	CLOSED	Thursdays	9:00 am - 7:00 pm
Mondays	9:00 am - 5:00 pm	Fridays	9:00 am - 5:00 pm
Tuesdays	9:00 am - 7:00 pm	Saturdays	CLOSED
Wednesdays	9:00 am - 5:00 pm		

Hours are subject to change as situations require, such as, but not limited to: emergencies, community health situations, power outages, and insufficient staffing options.

- In the event of a short-term closure or change in service, the Library Director, with the approval of the Board Chair or Vice-Chair, shall determine the best course of action.
- In the event of a long-term closure or change in service, the Library Director, with the approval of the Board Chair or Vice-Chair, shall determine the best course of action until the next Board meeting.

All legal state holidays ([MCA § 1-1-216](#)) and any other planned closures shall be approved by the Board and available to view on the Library's website.

Notice of a closure will be posted on the Library's front door.
